

FINANCIAL HARDSHIP IN YOUR STATE

FLORIDA

Statewide, there are 8,944,469 households (47%) that can't afford the basics. These households fall below the ALICE Threshold, which includes households in poverty and **ALICE®** (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed) households. Struggling yet hidden in plain sight, ALICE earns above the poverty level, but less than the cost of basics.
